
## Celebration of God's Goodness!

## A note from Reverend Phil...

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. (James 1:22)

On Sunday July 16<sup>th</sup>, we had a ministry fair. This was an opportunity for the church to meet with our Single Board chairs and engage in a dialogue of needs and dreams. Afterward I still had many questions about this new single board leadership model and how it works. I decided that I would dedicate this article to answering these questions.

Most churches work with a corporate structure with the pastor as the CEO. I feel this limits the church to the passions, skills, and personal preferences of the pastors. Because we are itinerating (meaning we serve at the call of the Bishop), we will move in and out of the life of the church that as a rule was here before we arrived and, God willing, will continue after we go. If the pastor serves as the CEO, then the character and direction of the church will ever be changing as pastors change. I feel this is a model that has hurt the church overall, and serves to put pastors into roles in which they cannot be successful. No single pastor will excel with finances, human resources, boilers, interior design, and whatever else happens in the life of the church. And quite frankly this is not our call. According to our Book of Discipline and the covenant we make in our calling, pastors;

"United Methodist clergy who are called to a ministry of *Word, Sacrament, Order, and Service*. This means pastors preach and teach the Word of God, provide pastoral care and counsel, administer the sacraments of baptism and Holy Communion, and order the life of the church for service in mission and ministry." (Adapted from GBHEM)

Pastor's call is into the spiritual call of the church, but I believe for consistency and relevance it is the church's responsibility to reveal the nature and character of God in the vision of the church, especially for relevance in the local culture. Therefore, we have created the Single Board model for leadership.

The vision of Single Board is to involve more people in leadership while honoring their time commitment. The goal is for our church family to be doers and not just listeners.

Each Single Board Chair has a responsibility over a specific area of the ministry of this church. Their job is to oversee this area and report to the board what is happening and what is needed. Each is assigned a budget to carry out the needs of their area, or if the need is larger than the budget, to come to Single Board with the recommendation of Finance to seek how to raise the necessary funding.









Each Chair is supported by teams that will support and inform the Chair to report to Single Board. For example, I will use some real issues some of our Chairs are working with. Trustees have a current project (probably completed by the time of printing this newsletter) of the fascia for the church. A team may get the bids, another can work with finance for funding, another can follow up with contractor for completion, and after reviewing all that is completed, the Chair will sign off for Finance to pay contractor and report to Single Board.

In Worship, the Chair will work with teams for Worship Design, Chancel (Altar) prep, music, and Tech Team... No one person must do it all, but just find that place where you serve in joy and trust in the other teams to get their part done so that worship will happen with integrity, all to the glory of Jesus Christ!

We are in the process of hiring a new Church Administrative Secretary. The Chair has a team who is working on advertising the position, another updating the job description and another who will do first interviews. As the pastor, I was involved in helping to update the job description, because this position is to assist in shepherding the church into their Kingdom vision, but I will not be involved in the reviewing of resumes or first round of interviews. It is up to the team that has accepted serving in this responsibility to do this important work, so that the pastor can focus on things of the Kingdom.

These are just some of the examples of what is necessary for the church to do its work, and how as the body of Christ all can be involved. Congregational Care has many teams to care for our congregation, Reaching and Receiving has many but needs even more to carry out their call in ministry, and Missions has many opportunities but also needs more dreamers and visionaries to do the work of increasing God's Kingdom Footprint in our community, from this place. There is a place for everyone to be involved in proclaiming the Good News of the Gospel to this generation from this place.

If you're not sure where the heart of your call fits, then just get together with me or our Lay Leader Chair Bill Scanlan; I am sure we can find a place that will allow you to serve with joy the heart and skills for God's glory. But remember, God does not call the prepared, God prepares the called!

Lord, let our prayer be one of trust and obedience. We know that you have called us to be light bringers into this generation. Guide our steps into Your call to make Disciples of Jesus Christ. Amen







#### MUMC Single Board Meeting July 18, 2017 Wesley Hall 6:00 p.m.

Chairperson Al Remling called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. in Wesley Hall. He led us in the call to worship which was a responsive reading from James 4:1-8. We are invited to submit ourselves to God, resist the devil and draw nearer to God and he will come near to us. God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble.

Prayers and praises were lifted up followed by a moment of silence and a prayer for guidance led by Al.

Finance reported the Donald Reth endowment fund has sent us a check in the amount of \$552.10 to be used for the education of our young people. Bruce gave the board a copy of the finance report to date. YTD income through June was \$136,189 and YTD expenses, including payment to apportionments, was \$115,559.00, giving us a surplus of \$20,630 as of June 30.

Trustees reported that the new carpet for the hallway behind the sanctuary will be done sometime this fall. They are awaiting bids on the tear down of the recently purchased house south of the church.

Christian Ed reported that VBS is in full swing with approximately 80 children from the community taking part this week. We are being assisted by help from the Presbyterian Church. Sunday School is looking ahead to new curriculum for the Fall.

Staff Parish is in the midst of looking to hire a new Office Manager due to the resignation of Debbie Saunders. Resumes need to be submitted by July 27 and they will be starting the interview process shortly after. Pastor would like to be in on the final interviews.

The ice cream social is August 2nd and many of the needed food items have been taken care of with a couple of exceptions.

Bill Scanlan, Lay Leader, gave a report on the recent Job Fair after church. He shared some thoughts and ideas with the board and discussion was held on how to improve on this process for the future. We are hoping to see some new volunteers on our teams.

**Action Items:** Moved by Marge Wolter, seconded by Randy Waterman to approve the new Safe Sanctuary Policy as presented. Motion carried.

Moved by Randy Waterman, seconded by Charlie Dighton, to fund apportionments for 2018 to 80% of asking. We will fully fund General Church and Conference Missions with the remaining going to Conference Ministries. Motion carried unanimously.

Adjourned at 8:20 p.m. Next meeting August 15 at 6:00 p.m.
