#### A note from Reverend Phil...

This year the church is participating in the Lenten study of "The Last Words of Christ" by Ralph F. Wilson. These encompass the last seven things Jesus said while on the cross, and what meaning they have for our lives and faith. Our study is completed on April 14th, (Palm Sunday) as we prepare to move into Holy Week. Every year our Worship Design team labors diligently to put together a series of worship services that will join together in the telling of this powerful story of Jesus passion for humanity. I can tell you in my 19 years of pastoral ministry, this is the finest worship effort I have ever witnessed.

It begins on Maundy Thursday as we enter into the story of the last supper, the foot washing, the prayer in the garden, and the arrest.

On Good Friday we return to the story of shame and pain, betrayal, crucify, and death.

Then on Easter Sunday we shall celebrate that He is Risen! Our salvation secured in sacrifice and our hope assured in resurrection!

Holy Week tells the story of the culmination of our history and eternal future with God. This is the story that is the very core of our faith and beliefs. This is the good news of the gospel we are compelled to share!

This year I would like to invite our whole church family to make a priority of our faith journey together and to attend all three of our Holy Week services this year. I would also compel you to invite another who would be blessed to experience the faith, hope, and love that is the gospel story. My prayer is that we all grow stronger in faith together into a greater image of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**Good Friday:** 7:00 PM in the Sanctuary **Easter Sunday:** 9:00 AM in the Sanctuary.


"Jesus said to her, I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die."

MUMC Single Board March 19, 2019 6:00 p.m. Wesley Hall

Single Board was called to order by Mark Reth at 6:00 p.m. in Wesley Hall. Mark led the board with a devotion focused on what we know as Palm Sunday as told in Luke 19: 37, 38. Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem riding on a donkey as foretold in prophecy from Zechariah is fulfilled. Jesus chose a time when all Israel would be gathered at Jerusalem as a way of proclaiming his mission that was unmistakable.

Prayers and praises were lifted up followed by a moment of silence and a prayer for guidance from Mark.

#### Team Reports:

Finance: Bruce shared the most recent Finance Report with the board. Actual expenses for January and February were \$36,448 and actual income was \$32,832 leaving a deficit of \$3,616. Inclement weather and cancelled church services have caused a decrease in giving. It was decided to let the congregation know of the importance of our monetary obligations.

Trustees: Charlie reported the Wesley Hall bathroom leak has been repaired. The frozen roof drain on the west end of fellowship hall is in need of a remedy before next winter. Work on the choir loft will be done on April 22 and 23. Anyone able to help Gary Evarts with this project needs to let the church office know. Estimates for new flooring for Wesley Hall will be available at our next board meeting. Trustees will be adding a new budget item next year for prevention maintenance of the building to help address some of the on going issues with an ageing building.

Christian Ed: Marge said that a Youth Council has been formed and there are five members of various ages involved. 88 people have signed up for and participating in our Lenten Study.

Missions: Barry said UMCOR is our mission focus and he has a mission team assembled to help him.

Staff Parish: Mike mentioned that Staff Parish will be meeting Thursday night to discuss items of interest including a written policy of paid holidays for staff, a written policy for our Administrative Assistant for working at home when the church is closed due to inclement weather and a review of our youth coordinator position.

Lay Ministry: Bill has assembled a lay ministry team with several members who will be helping with ideas from our recent "Kingdom Vision and Mission" meeting.

There were no action items.

Mike Wade is still looking at a policy for church closings due to weather. More information and input is needed to make an informed decision and will be brought to the board.

The next Single Board meeting will be on April 23 at 6:00 p.m. in Wesley Hall. This is a week later than usual due to Holy Week.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m. followed by the Lord's prayer and singing of the doxology.

## VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

With all this crazy winter weather we're all dreaming of summer, so let's begin planning Vacation Bible School!

This year's theme is ROAR: Life is wild, God is good! The kids are in for a wild week, but it won't be possible without YOUR help! This year's VBS will be July 15-19 from 9:00-11:45 a.m., and we are in need of preschool leaders, station leaders, crew leaders, and decoration leaders. Descriptions of these positions are below. If you are interested in helping with any aspect of VBS, please contact Hannah Clemen at 563-929-1395 or hannahclemen21@gmail.com or contact the church office @ (563) 927-4439.

**LITTLE PAWS PRESCHOOL LEADERS (Adults):** Rather than have our 3 & 4-year-olds rotate through the stations with the older kids, they have their own class. We need two or three adults to lead this class. Crew leaders will help organize these kids and assist the leaders.

**STATION LEADERS (Adults):** Students (who are grouped in crews) move through various stations that are staffed by an adult leader and feature a different Bible-learning activity. You are the "teacher" for your station. Crews are at your station for approximately 20 minutes. Stations include:

**Imagination Station Leader:** This individual leads the kids through science experiments using fun gizmos that connect to the day's Bible story.

**Stampede Sports Leader:** This enthusiastic individual leads the crews through a variety of games that connect with the daily Bible Point or Bible story. There are always a variety of games for the leader to choose from to best suit the kids at our VBS.

**CREW LEADERS (HS Students or Adults):** These individuals are assigned to a group of approximately 6 kids. They lead their crew through each station assisting the station leaders as needed.

**SONG LEADERS (MS/HS Students or Adults):** These energetic individuals learn the songs and actions and lead the kids in singing during opening and closing.

**DECORATION LEADERS:** Creative individuals with great vision and ingenuity are needed to turn the Narthex and sanctuary into a African savannah.

With approximately 75 kids attending VBS each summer, we need at least 12 crew leaders in addition to at least 6 station leaders and 2-3 preschool teachers to make VBS a success. We also need creative people to help decorate the church, people to man the registration table, assistants for the station leaders, and much more. Those looking to volunteer and those who already have (even if you've helped in the past) should fill out the registration form and get it turned in ASAP. Please consider how you can use your talents and gifts to benefit the children who attend this year's VBS!


