

Prayers and praises were lifted up followed by a prayer for guidance from Pastor Phil.

Finance:

- 1. The Fund Balance Report has been completed and filed.
- 2. Endowment There was a letter from Pfizer that stock from Viatris has been purchased and MUMC now has 24 shares and will be receiving dividends from this stock also.
- 3. Notice was received on 12/21/2020 that the PPP loan had been forgiven. Paperwork was received on 1/15/2021
- 4. Reth Endowment Received notice from conference that the yearly 5% will be in the amount of \$297.00 and will be used for Christian Education.
- 5. Apportionments for the year 2020 in the amount of \$34,226 were paid in full
- 6. The year end report was given. Contributions \$231,865 Expenses \$221,782 Brick-by-Brick has a year ending balance of \$103,000

Trustees: Charlie reported that the boiler will be inspected on 3/9/2021. The city has sent notification that the sidewalk in front of the parsonage needs some work. The refrigerator in the parlor will need to be replaced.

Worship: Ruth advised that recording will continue for Epworth and Colesburg for a very short period.

Christian Ed: Youth are meeting on Wednesday night and there will be more programs come spring.

Missions: Wayne reported that there had been no activity since the money was sent to Delaware County Pay It Forward. Pastor Phil advised that MUMC had received a thank you note from that committee.

Reaching & Receiving: Janine advised that there would not be greeters and the ushers would be greeting as everyone is escorted to their pew.

Congregational Care: There has been no meeting.

Staff Parish: Mike Wade is asking for volunteers to staff the office while Kat is on maternity leave. This would preferably for a week at a time for the next approx. 3 weeks.

Lay Ministry: Bill would like to have a return celebration in the fall, pending the outcome of COVID.

There was discussion on general topics following the reports.

The meeting adjourned at 7:25 PM followed by prayer by Pastor Phil. Next meeting will be February 16, 2021 at 6:00 PM by Zoom.
