## A note from Pastor Phil...

When times are good, be happy; but when times are bad, consider this: God has made the one as well as the other. Therefore, no one can discover anything about their future. -Ecclesiastes 7:14 (NIV)

For months now a small group has been planning a big event that would launch our church family back into our "Normal" schedule declaring victory in this time of pandemic... We have survived, in fact through it all we have thrived! We are going to have an old time tent revival with food, music by the new contemporary band, and Pastor was going to bring a strong message of encouragement and hope from the scriptures of 1 Kings...

- Then the Covid positivity numbers dramatically increased...
- Then the construction started on the floor in Wesley Hall... Had to move the Revival to September 15th.
- Then we had a reduction, rather than an increase in worship numbers...

• Then last Sunday our Finance Chair had to share that we are actually behind spending a few thousand dollars, for the first time since October 2015.

So what have we to celebrate? It just seems like the hits keep coming! Pay attention to the Ecclesiastes scripture listed above... God is in both our joy and our sorrow. God understands our hopes and disappointments. Both are a part of this life we live together, but in God shall we be overcome? In the midst of our disappointments, we have had worship visitors virtually every week since we have returned to live worship without masks. So far this year we have received seven new members, and already have another scheduled for September. When we were not planning a confirmation class this year, we will have one anyway, and there could be up to eight enrolled. We are doing Confirmation in partnership with four other churches. We have two baptisms already scheduled for later this year. I am constantly hearing from people who are watching our services online or on the radio. We are sharing God's love story in this difficult time right now. Imagine how hard these times would be if we didn't know where our eternal hope is found?

I am hearing some are staying home yet due to Covid concerns... Some have discovered they like "Pajama church" (though you are missed... I wouldn't care if you came to church in your pajamas...) I have been told that since they watch online or listen to the radio, they have forgotten or have failed to make a priority of bringing in their offerings... We are still working on this "new normal." BUt through it all, it appears as God shall continue to bless us to move forward in our ministries together so that Jesus Christ is glorified.

So, lets come together on September 15, 2021 for a revival together... Where we recognize all that God has done, is doing, and has yet to do through this body known as Manchester UMC! Dinner at 5:30, worship from 6:30 to 8:00! There will be an intermission with drinks and dessert. Invite your family, neighbors, and friends! Let us encourage one another, and our new Worship band in their debut! Let us change our outlook into that of the Psalmist 118:24;

#### MUMC Single Board August 17, 2021 6:00 p.m. Wesley Hall

**Present:** Kathy Dolan, Charlie Dighton, Wayne Birkenholz, Pam Vap, Ruth Voshell, Pastor Phil, Mike Wade, Bill Scanlan, Bruce Nodurft, Janine Stellick, Jean Gross, Mark Reth.

Kathy Dolan called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. in the absence of Mark Reth who joined us later. She led us in a devotional from Psalms 119: 89-95. This scripture reminds us of the key to living victoriously during the dark periods of life. Recalling God's faithfulness and control over everything that touches us gives us strength to walk with God even when we feel like giving up in despair. God is perfectly capable of sustaining us if we will only let Him.

Prayers and Praises were lifted up followed by a moment of silence and a prayer for guidance from Pastor Phil.

**Finance:** Bruce reminded us that the new budget needs to be done by the October 19 Single Board meeting. Budget request forms were passed out. Year to date actual income is \$126,985 and actual expenses were \$119,057 without apportionment payments due amounting to \$17,360. We are behind -\$13,634 from last year's giving. We need to be diligent in our giving to the church in order to meet all of our expenses. Seventeen giving units donated to the new church flooring amounting to \$21,145.

**Trustees:** Charlie reported the vent work in the kitchen is being done. If we decide to convert the women's restrooms to family bathrooms they will need to be handicapped accessible. It appears that if the short wall is removed it will be possible to accommodate that requirement. One air conditioner on the south wall in Wesley Hall is not working and parts are no longer available and another one on that wall is making noise. Trustees are looking into replacing all three of the south wall units with new ones that should be able to cool the whole dining area with the two on the north wall to be kept if needed. August 25 is a possible date for the beginning work on new flooring in Wesley Hall and surrounding areas. This will be done in two stages and that area will be blocked off for safety reasons. Second Helpings may not be able to use the hall for up to three weeks. Church services will proceed as usual.

**Worship:** Ruth said the new sound board is working thanks to Michael and Nicholas Stocks and Beth Mueller. **Christian Ed:** Sunday School is scheduled to begin on September 12. The 10:15 service will be moved to 10:30 at that time.

**Missions:** The recommendation is being made to move the Revival from September 8 to September 15 due to the new floor work. Second Helpings is in need of meat donations. The Clothing Closet needs more staff so it can be open during Second Helpings as well as during Wednesday night when those services start. Help will be needed moving items for the floor replacement. October 23 from 4:00-7:00 is scheduled for a Chili Cook-off with a free will offering going towards water wells in Africa.

**Congregational Care:** The Safety Committee is recommending we keep our two services at this time due to the covid variant which is present in Delaware County. This will be readdressed again as needed.

**Staff Parish:** Dennis will be on vacation next week. Due to the work being done in Wesley Hall it was decided to forego a replacement in his absence. Anyone using a wastebasket is urged to empty it as needed.

**Pastor Phil** reminded us that Charge Conference is scheduled for November 2nd. He has had his yearly interview and will be able to bless us with his presence another year!

Meeting adjourned at 8:30. Next meeting will be September 21 in Wesley Hall.


