#### A note from Pastor Phil...

By the sweat of your brow you will eat your food until you return to the ground, since from it you were taken; for dust you are and to dust you will return." 
Genesis 3:19

Adam and Eve were created in the image of God to share in fellowship and to walk the Garden of Creation with God. They were only given one stipulation- do not eat of the fruit of the tree in the center of the Garden! We all know how the story goes: the serpent tricked and goaded Eve into eating the fruit, and then Eve convinced Adam. And God's initial plan of quiet fellowship within the Garden was interrupted by humanity's brokenness. We have become self aware of good and evil and sought to meet our own selfish desires. Here we are many thousands of years later, and we still suffer with the same symptoms of our human condition.

Lord, we need saving, we just cannot do this on our own! Our own righteousness is stained and we can not cleanse it without you... Wash away our sin, lord, share with us Your own perfect and holy righteousness, We shall trust in You our Lord Jesus Christ!

But the cost of salvation came at a very high price. The sacrifice of the perfect lamb without blemish. The sacrifice of the one who remained sinless. The Holy Son of God. For our salvation we must only repent and believe. Seems easy, but it is apparently hard for this generation. So many in the church preach a false message of cheap grace... You only need to believe! God's love is abundant and all dogs go to heaven! There is no reason we should humble ourselves and repent- that foolish talk. Is it?

At the beginning of Jesus' ministry he proclaimed "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!" (Mark 1:15) I have read through God's Word many times and have yet to find a scripture that refutes this command, though I have found numerous in support. All paths of salvation lead to Jesus Christ, and we must come humble, repenting of our sin, and accepting in truth the teachings of the Good news. We may find humbling ourselves for our iniquity hard, due to our pride and ego, but nevertheless it is required to be fully in relationship with the Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

This year for Lent we are putting an emphasis on our journey of redemption beginning with the Ash Wednesday worship service all the way through to Easter. I compel all of the congregation to make all worship services. On Ash Wednesday I pray all can come for worship as we humble ourselves and recognize our own need for a Savior. Then we will spend our Lent worship services studying from the book "The Face of Forgiveness" by Philip D. Jamieson.

Come and see all that the Holy Spirit has for you in these worship experiences. Find your rest in the sanctuary as God molds and makes us into a greater image of the Dive. Be prepared to go and tell of the abundance of grace, love, and hope found in our Risen Savior Jesus Christ, so that others may hear and also be saved.


