### A note from Pastor Phil...

A prophecy: The word of the Lord to Israel through Malachi.

2 "I have loved you," says the Lord. "But you ask, 'How have you loved us?'

- Malachi 1:1-2

The last of the Old Testament prophets recorded in scripture was Malachi. The time of Malachi's prophecies would have been at the end or shortly after the time of Nehemiah's prophecies. The Israelites had returned from exile, and rebuilt the temple and city walls of Jerusalem. The labor was hard, and the neighbor's were threatening... The people of Israel began asking the questions, where is God? And because God was not meeting their expectations, they began seeking other God's of their own making and once again stopped worshiping God with integrity and fullness. Through the Prophet Malachi God sends a message to the people of Israel that is both encouraging and troubling. I can not help to see that still today the human condition seems to follow the same cyclical paths.

Since January of 2020 our cultural reality has been one of consistent drama and struggle. First we have political conflict around a presidential election, then a global pandemic, then isolation and fear, only to come out of all this into a denominational crisis which also led our own church family to know some conflict. Imagine that, 300ish members could not agree on a single way forward? Though our vote to disaffiliate was over 80% and to join Global Methodist was over 90% this is still less than unanimous. We find ourselves asking, where is God? We have been through so much...

Through the Prophet Malachi, God proclaims-"I have loved you!" Can we not also inquire in our frustration- "Where have You loved us?" Though I believe that God has set the stage for Manchester Methodist Church to enter once again into a time of revival as a beacon in our community of Christian faith, we must admit that the road to this place has been hard.

Starting the first Sunday in June we will begin a new worship study of the Book of Malachi titled- "Starting Over... Again." As we engage in a Holy conversation of what it means to be a people chosen by God. Being chosen does not mean that all things shall be easy. Being chosen does not mean that we will find ourselves in full agreement. Most important, being chosen means that we have been called, and we rest in Peace with God. Now in this unique time, from this unique place, we are tasked with going to tell the love story of God with humanity, so that all may know and be saved. Amen

We are still looking for the following volunteer positions to be filled:

**STATION LEADERS (Adults):** Students (who are grouped in crews) move through various stations that are stationed by an adult leader and feature a different Bible-learning activity. You are the "teacher" for your station. Crews are at your station for approximately 20 minutes. Stations

#### include:

- \*\*Games: This enthusiastic individual leads the crews through a variety of games that connect with the daily Bible Point or Bible story. There are always a variety of games for the leader to choose from to best suit the kids at our VBS.
- \*\*Bible Leader: This organized storyteller brings the Bible to life for groups of elementary age kids through interactive and engaging experiences, then helps kids apply the word of God to their own lives.

**ELEMENTARY CREW LEADERS (HS Students or Adults):** These individuals are assigned to a group of approximately 6 kids. They lead their crew through each station assisting the station leaders as needed.

PRESCHOOL CREW LEADERS/HELPERS (MS OR HS STUDENTS, ADULTS): Rather than have our three to five-year-olds rotate through the stations with the older kids, they have their own class. We still need 3 or 4 more helpers for this class. Crew leaders will help organize these kids and assist the leaders.

**STATION HELPER (MS Students):** These helpers assist the station leaders with anything they need extra hand with.

**PRESCHOOL GAMES & CRAFT TEACHER (ADULT):** This patient and creative leader manages materials and guides groups of preschoolers through creating a variety of Bible point reinforcing crafts. This energetic, patient, and organized individual is in charge of leading preschool age kids in fun activities and discussions. You don't need to be an Olympian, you just need to be organized, energetic, and fun loving.
